

## Scope of Services

### Mississippi Coalition for Citizens with Disabilities

- Coordinate with partner agencies in supplying the good/services to address unmet needs to the target population.
- Eliminate the fiscal barrier to resources to complete recovery.
- Work with partner agencies to complete individual/families recovery process.
- Maintain documentation of funding expended for each client.
- Fully complete recovery process for remaining 35 clients identified by partners in this alliance by September 30, 2009
- Complete all paperwork required of grant

### American Red Cross – Southeast Mississippi Chapter

- Provide case management services for 35 identified hurricane survivors/families.
- Complete the recovery process utilizing current identified cases within the target population.
- Coordinate with fiscal agent and other partners in supplying goods/services to address unmet needs to the target population.
- Coordinate outside material donations with funding from grant to eliminate the fiscal barrier to resources to complete recovery.
- Coordinate with partner volunteer agency to complete individual/families' recovery process.
- Provide documentation of funding expended for each individual/family.

### Lutheran Episcopal Services in Mississippi/Camp Victor

- Complete the recovery process for 35 current identified cases
- Match volunteer skills with repairs and requested labor as identified in scope of work per client
- Ensure skilled labor projects are completed appropriately and by licensed contractors when required by city ordinances.
- Provide warehouse space for materials and provide documentation of expenditure of donated and/or purchased materials.
